State of Mississippi Department of Mental Health Selects the Coordinated Care Platform

Overall, the CCP will provide Mississippi behavioral health and IDD programs with person-centric and integrated EHR and case management, enabling all the programs to share a common platform, facilitating coordinated care for and transition of individuals to community-based programs. These vital components for coordinating care within and between programs also provide powerful analytics tools to meet the State's reporting needs as well as Federal requirements for Meaningful Use of electronic health records.

Acting as a central point of access, in addition to standardizing interfaces with ancillary systems, the CCP will also provide centralized back-up and security and improve disaster recovery to ensure business continuity. Added James Dunaway, Chief Information Officer, "the [CCP] will allow us to centralize the data for our programs, eliminating duplication of data and eliminating the need for multiple local databases." Dunaway continued, "This means that our programs will have centralized access to the system and the files will be preserved and accessible even in the event of a disaster in the region."
